## Instructions puzzle:

Answer the questions below. Find the answers in the puzzle and color in the blocks. Start by the number of your question and find the letters in the correct order. The word can go left/right/up/down, but the letters will always be in the correct order and attached to each other, with the exception of \#7. An arrow has been placed to show where to continue that word. Question 1 has already been colored in for you to show you how it works. (Since there was one letter short, one block has already been colored blue, so that the puzzle will make sense).

When you are finished, it will show two words from the Bible text you need to figure out at the end. All the letters with an ${ }^{\circ}$ by it are to be used to complete the Bible text. It answers what the man of Macedonia said in Paul's vision.
