Names of Christ

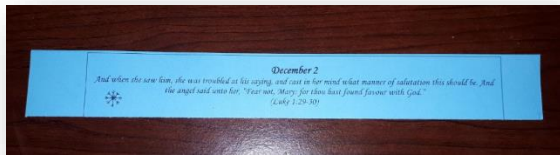


What do you need?

- ✂ 4 sheets of coloured paper (cardstock works fine too)
- ✂ Scissors and / or paper cutter
- ✂ Tape and / or stapler
- ✂ Optional: pencil crayons, felts, and / or stickers

How do you make the calendar?

1. Print or photocopy the calendar strips and the star unto coloured paper or cardstock. You can use three different colours for the strips in order to make a pattern in your paper chain. You can choose a fourth colour for the star.



2. Cut all the strips with scissors or with a paper cutter. If you leave about a centimeter of extra paper on both sides of each strip, it will make it easier to tape or staple the strips.

3. Start with one of the strips. Tape or staple the two sides of the strip together, with the Bible text on the outside.

4. Put the next strip of paper through the first circle, and tape or staple the sides of that strip together. Continue to do this with all the strips. There is no particular order, so you can arrange them however you like.

5. Cut out the star. If you'd like to, you can decorate the star with pencil crayons, felts, or stickers.

6. Tape or staple one end of your chain onto the bottom of the star.

7. Your advent calendar is ready! On every day in December, you can take a link off and find the Bible verse mentioned on this link. What name of Christ can you read in that Bible verse?
