

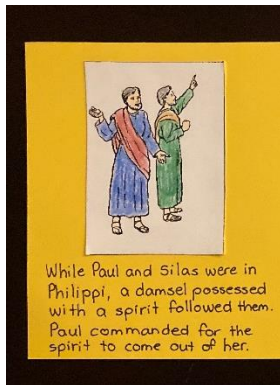
## Craft: Timeline of Paul and Silas sent to prison in Philippi

### Supplies:

- Template with pictures
- Coloring pencils
- 2 cardstock papers, both cut in half to make 4 papers of 8.5"x5.5" (21.6 cm x 14 cm)
- Tape
- Glue

### Instructions:

- Color the pictures. NOTE: The picture of the 3 men listening, look like soldiers. However, I colored their clothing all grey/black to make them look like prisoners, since in the Bible it speaks about 'and the prisoners heard them'.
- Cut out the pictures and place them in the correct order.
- Tape the four pieces of cardstock side by side, to make a long strip of paper for a timeline. Place the pictures in the correct order on the



cardstock, trying to space them evenly, and glue them in place. (Tip: glue them close enough to the top, so there is room enough below to write what happened at each picture.)

- Under each picture write what took place, to make a story timeline of what took place around the time that Paul and Silas were cast in prison. You can use your own wording, or use texts from the Bible:

Picture 1 – Acts 16:18m

Picture 2 – Acts 16:19a + 23b

Picture 3 – Acts 16:24

Picture 4 – Acts 16:25

Picture 5 – Acts 16: 26 + 27

Picture 6 – Acts 16: 30 + 31
