
Daniel 2: Craft instructions


Items needed:


- Printed templates (next two pages)
- Scissors
- Glue

Instructions:

- Cut out the pieces of the body of the image. For the head, cut it out around the head to make it fit better. All the other body parts can just be cut around the box.
- Glue the pieces in the correct order to make the image. It works best to start with the feet and work your way up, so that part of the head can be put over top of the chest.







Instructions:

Students cut apart each section of the statue. Then glue the pieces in sequence on the description page.

The GOLD head of the STATUE represents the kingdom of Babylon


The kingdom to come after Babylon is represented by the SILVER chest and arms.

After that kingdom will come another, represented by the BRASS hips.

Then will come another kingdom made of IRON, which will divide in two.

Then will come another kingdom represented by IRON and CLAY mixed together.
