Daniel craft instructions

Needed:

- Templates, printed on white cardstock
- Watercolours (or crayons, pencil crayons, felts, or paint)
- Piece of coloured cardstock
- Scissors and glue
- Craft knife

Instructions:

- Colour Daniel, the window and wall, and the praying hands. I used watercolours, but you can also use crayons, pencil crayons, felt, or paint.
- Cut the frame with Daniel in it. Use the tip of your scissors to lightly score the lines between the frame and the glue strips. Fold the glue strips.
- Cut the window and wall. Use a craft knife to carefully cut the top, bottom, and middle lines of the window, so the windows can open.
- Glue the frame with Daniel behind the open window. The glue strips are glued to the back sides of the window frame. The frame with Daniel will be curved once it is glued onto the window frame, so it will stand up.
- Cut the hands and the Bible texts.
- Take a piece of coloured cardstock, and fold it in half, so it will stand (see picture below).



- Glue the Bible text on the cardstock. Glue the praying hands to the side of the cardstock.
- Place the Bible text with the praying hands in front of the open window.
