Acts 13:13-15	Salamis and Paphos	John left Paul and Barnabas at this city, to go back to Jerusalem.
Acts 13:16-52	Antioch (Pisidia)	Paul preached in the synagogues. Jews stirred up people, but many Gentiles ordained to eternal life.
Acts 14:1-6	Derbe	Healed man impotent on his feet. The inhabitants thought Paul and Barnabas were gods and wanted to sacrifice to them.
Acts 14:7-20	Iconium	Preached the Gospel and taught many.
Acts 14:20-21	Lystra	Spoke in the synagogue and a great multitude of both Jews and Gentiles believed.
Acts 14:21-23	Perga (return trip)	Returning, confirmed and exhorted the disciples in the cities. And ordained elders in every church.
Acts 14:25	Lystra, Iconium and Antioch (return trip)	Rehearsed to the church what God had done with them on their journey. Stayed here for quite some time.
Acts 14:25-26	Antioch	Upon return from other cities, preached here.
Acts 14:26-28	Attalia	Sailed from this city back to Antioch (Syria).
