

Praying Hands Craft

What do you need?

- ✂ Coloured cardstock
- ✂ Copy of the Lord's Prayer (see below)
- ✂ Pencil crayons
- ✂ Scissors
- ✂ Glue



How do you make it?



1. Fold the sheet of cardstock in half. Lay your hand on it, with your little finger against the fold. Trace your hand.

2. Keep the cardstock folded, and cut out your hand. Don't cut on the fold.



3. Colour the Lord's Prayer with pencil crayons. You can decorate around it too if you would like to. You could for example draw a cloud by *Our Father, Which art in heaven*, a crown by *Thy kingdom come*, a loaf of bread by *Give us this day our daily bread*, etc.



4. Cut the three strips. Leave the edges on, so you can glue the strips together (see picture).

5. Glue the three strips together, and fold it like a harmonica.



6. Glue the two ends of the long strip into the hands. Because of the harmonica fold, it will fold up like a booklet.

7. You can now read and memorize the Lord's prayer!
